Onion DAMANI

Allium cepa L.

DAMANI is a short day onion, Galmi type. Very popular in Subsaharian Africa, this variety is very well adapted to the environmental conditions of this region. Our continuous breeding work on this variety is among others, maintaining a low splitting rate and a bolting rate as low as possible. The bulb is flattened thick with a light purple skin and a thin neck. DAMANI has a very good storage when it's harvested to complete maturity (around 80% of falling) and stored in a well ventilated room.

- Light purple skin
- Flattened thick shape
- Medium size
- Thin neck
- Very pungent

MATURITY

- 100 to 110 days after transplanting

STORAGE

- Very good storage ability in a well ventilated room and protected from the rain
